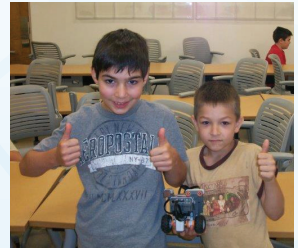

They will be introduced to a variety of engineering related concepts, including aerodynamics, forces and motion, fluid dynamics, material strength, and the design process. This is a full day camp in which the educational portion is a half day that will take place in our-state-of-the-art engineering building on campus, the Ed Lumley Centre for Engineering Innovation (CEI). The other half of the day will include outdoor activities and swimming at the St. Denis Centre. Maximum of 30 participants per session.

LEADER IN TRAINING CAMP

During their first week, campers will complete their CPR training while participating in a number of leadership seminars, and team building activities. Successful completion of the first week, will grant campers the opportunity to be placed in one of our Lancer Camps during week two. This will provide valuable first-hand experience in leadership, while satisfying the requirements of their 40 community service hours.
