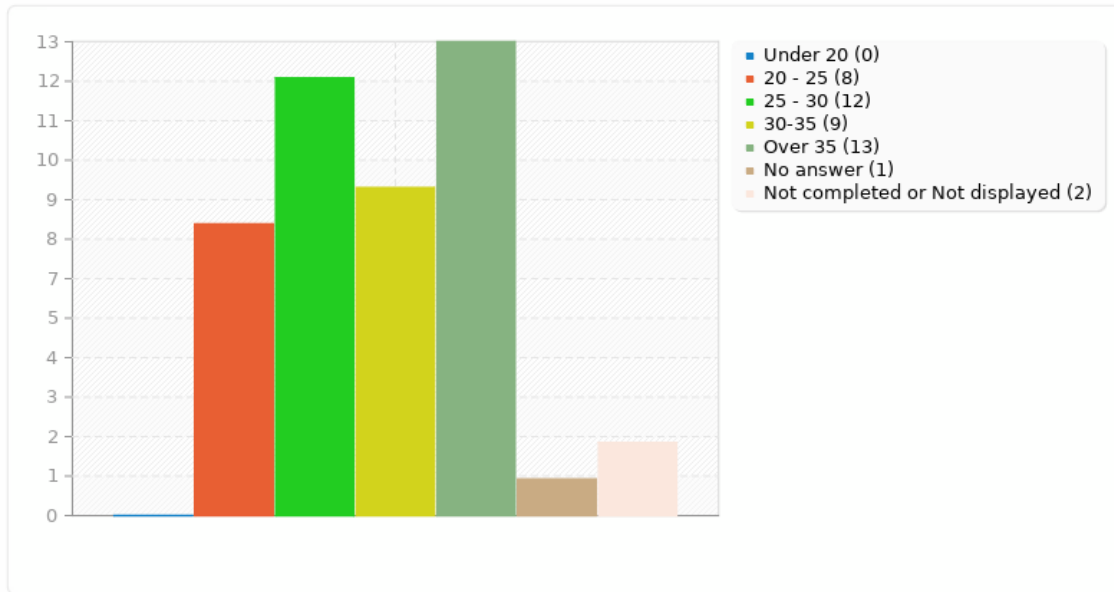

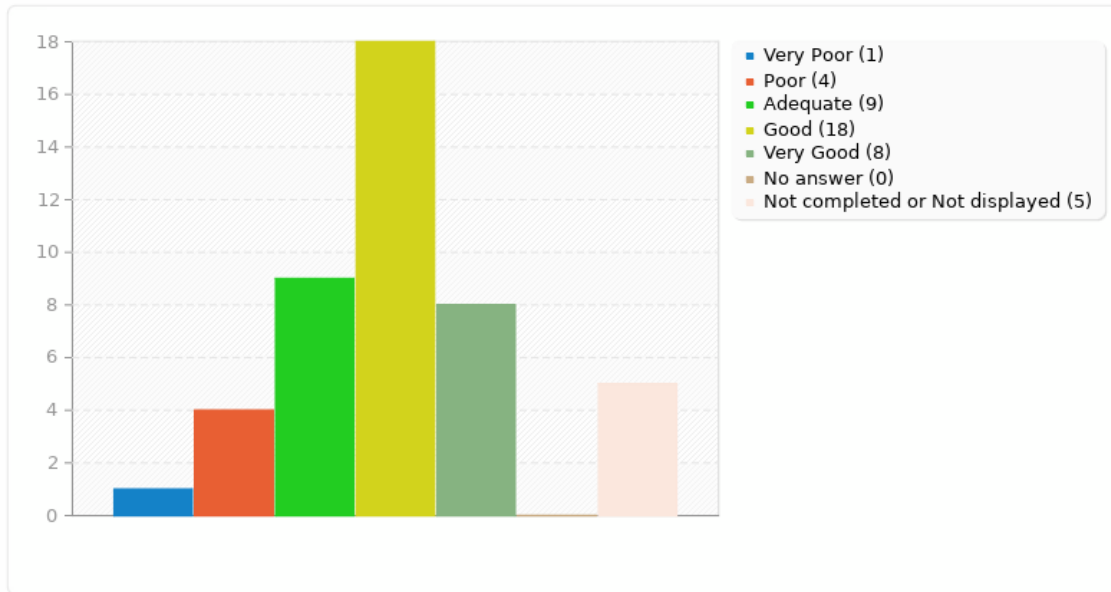

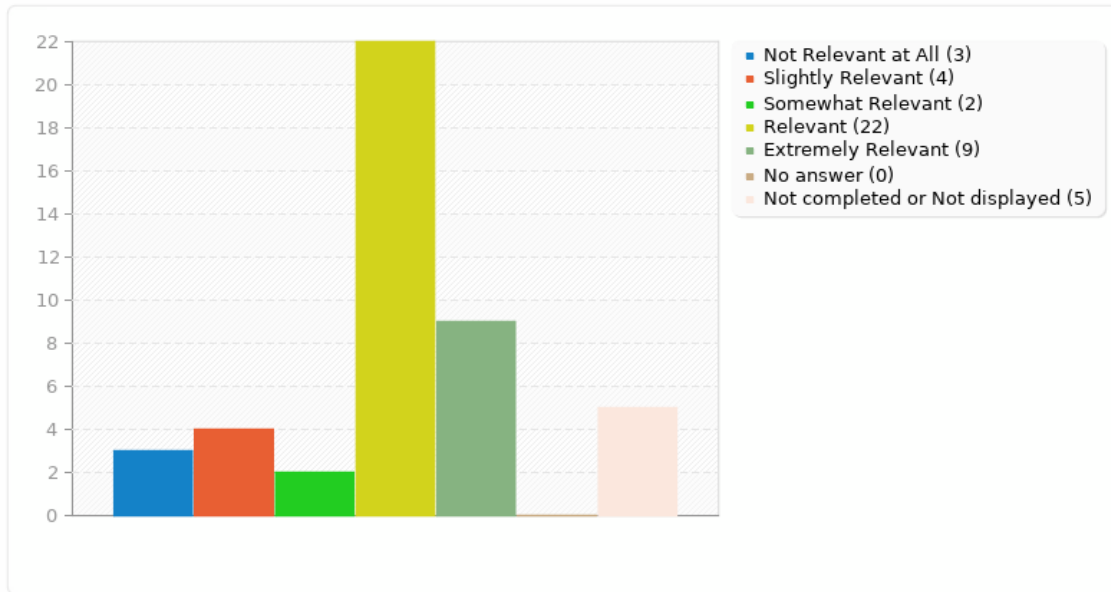

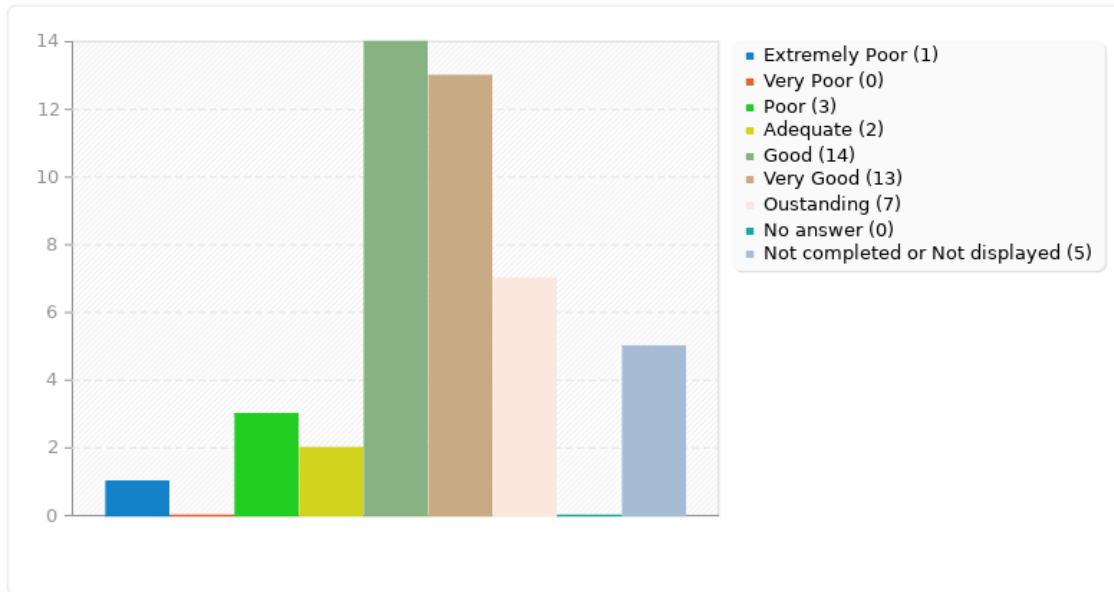

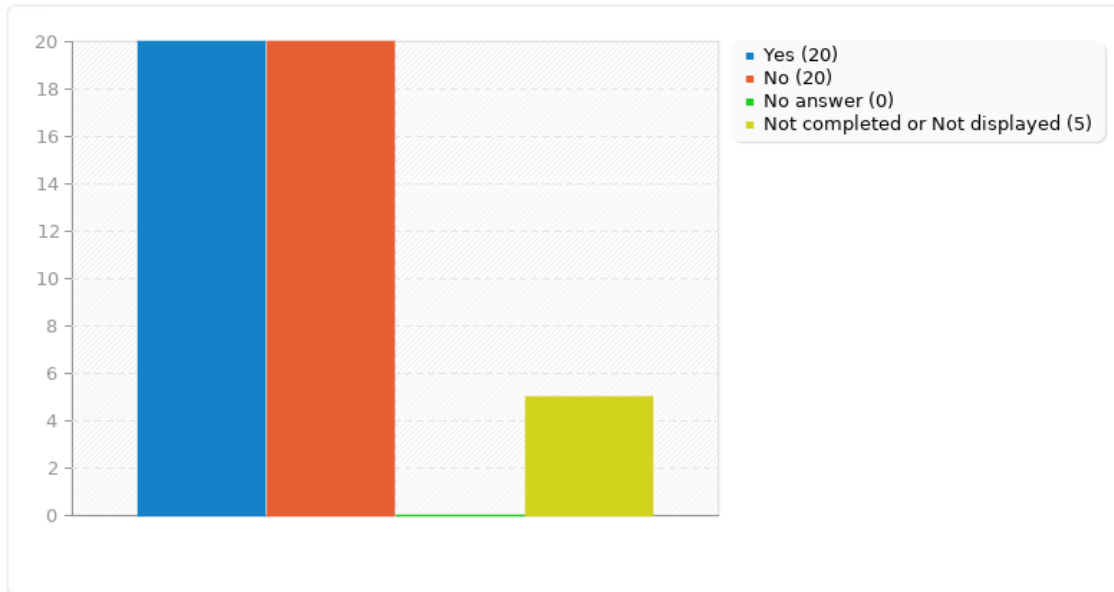

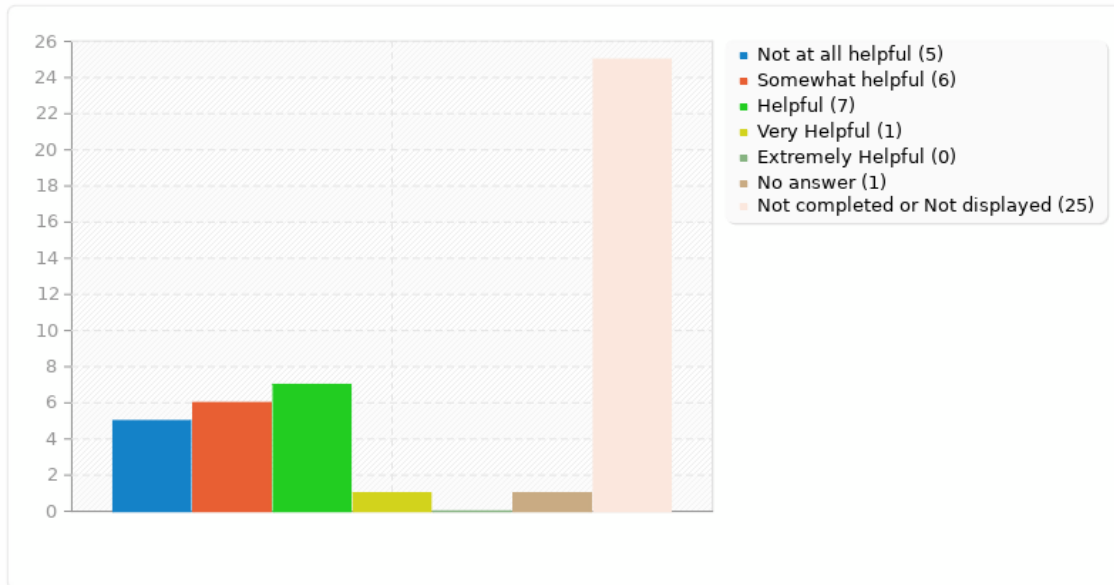

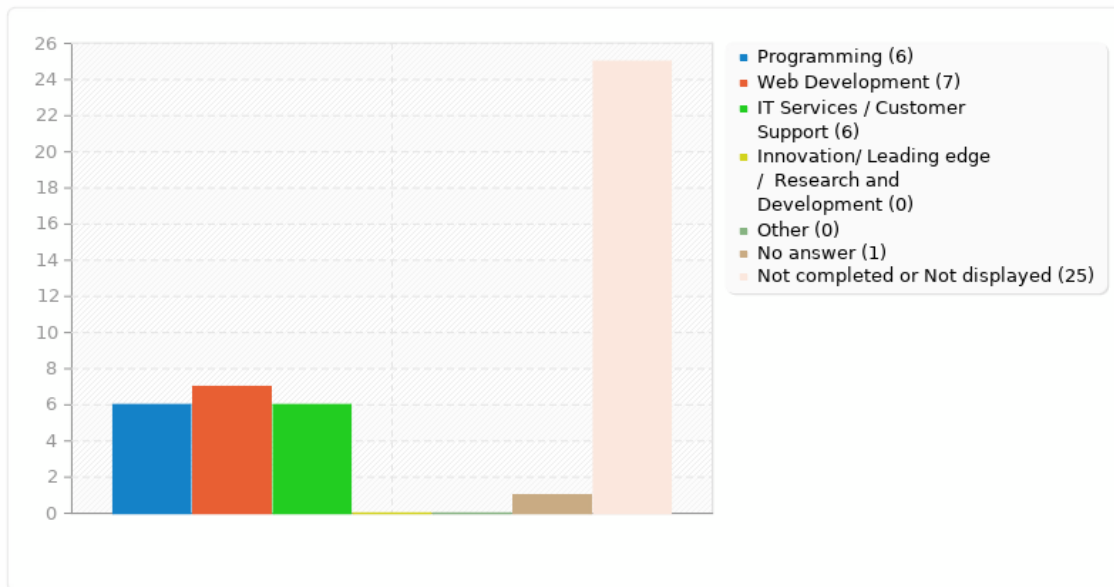

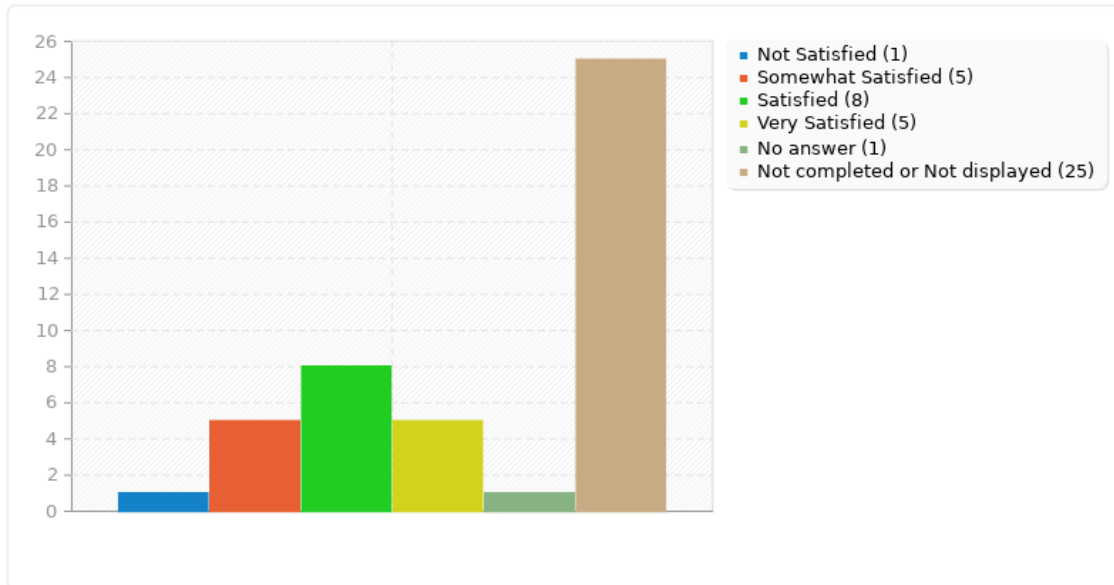

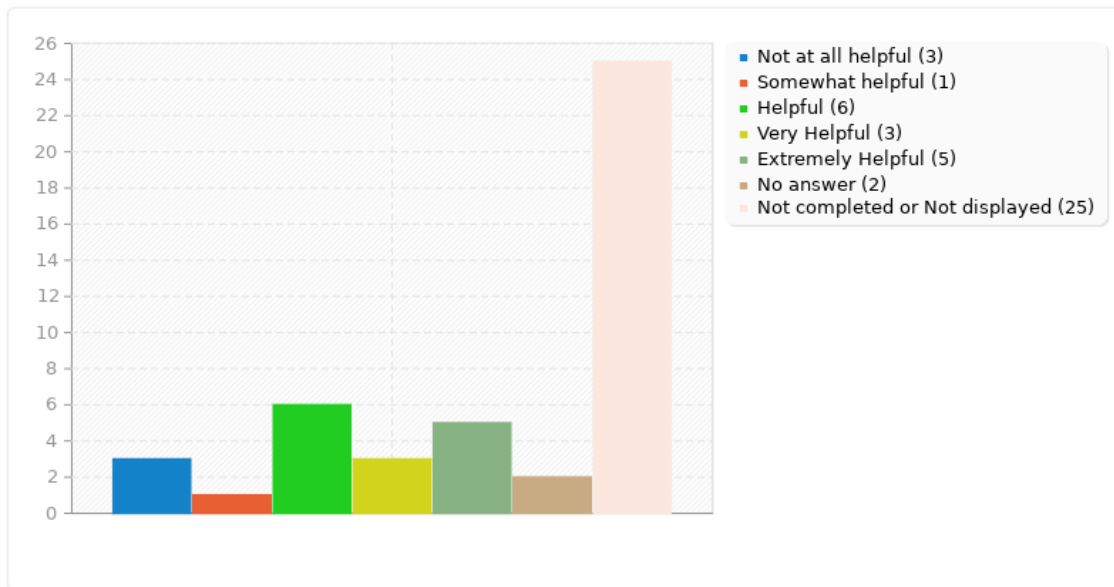

How well did your co-operative education or internship help you to obtain your first professional job after graduating?



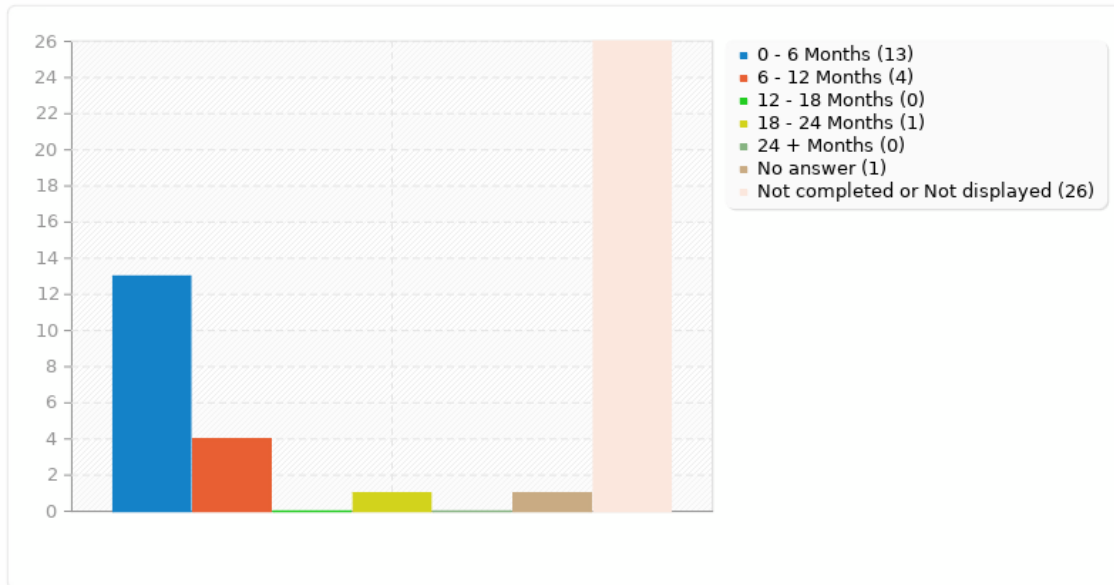

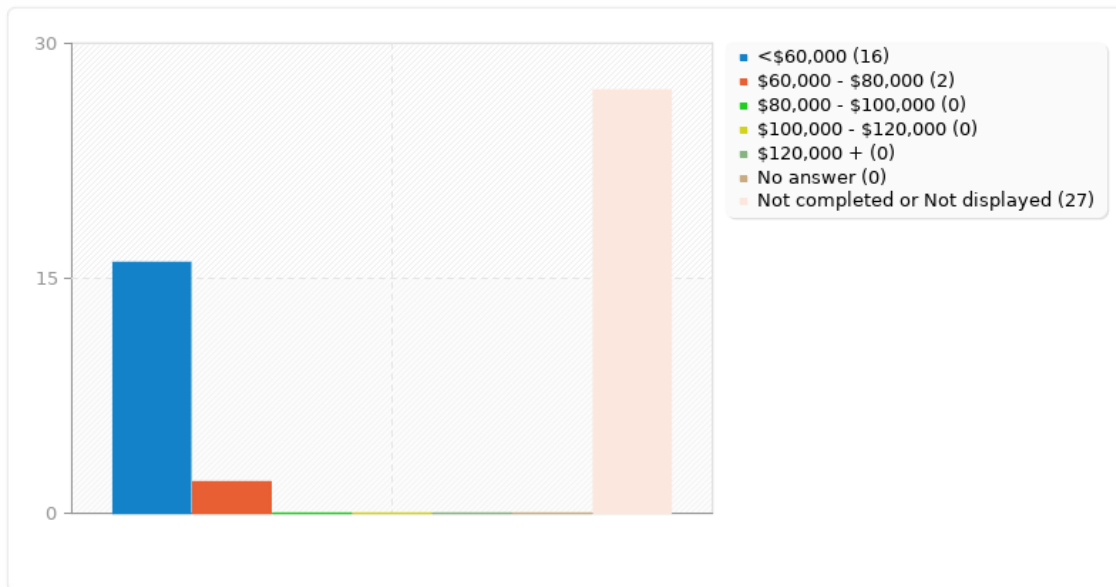

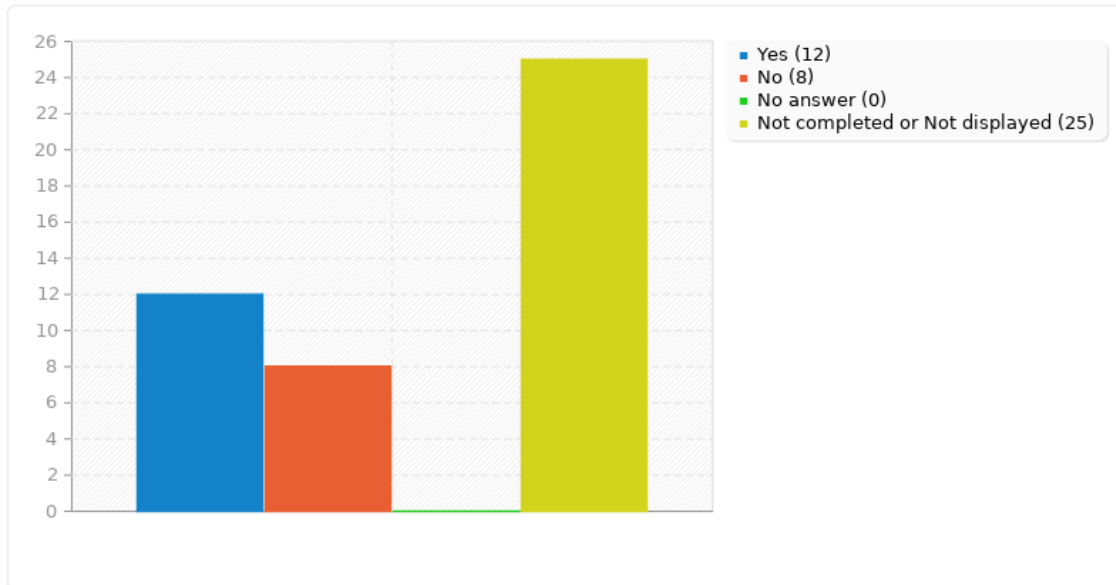

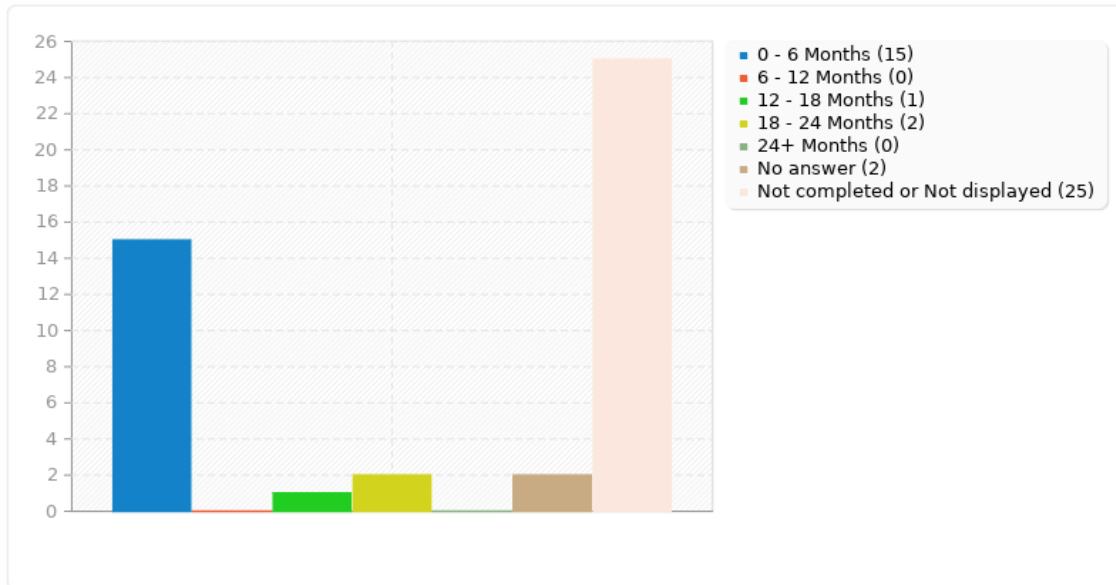

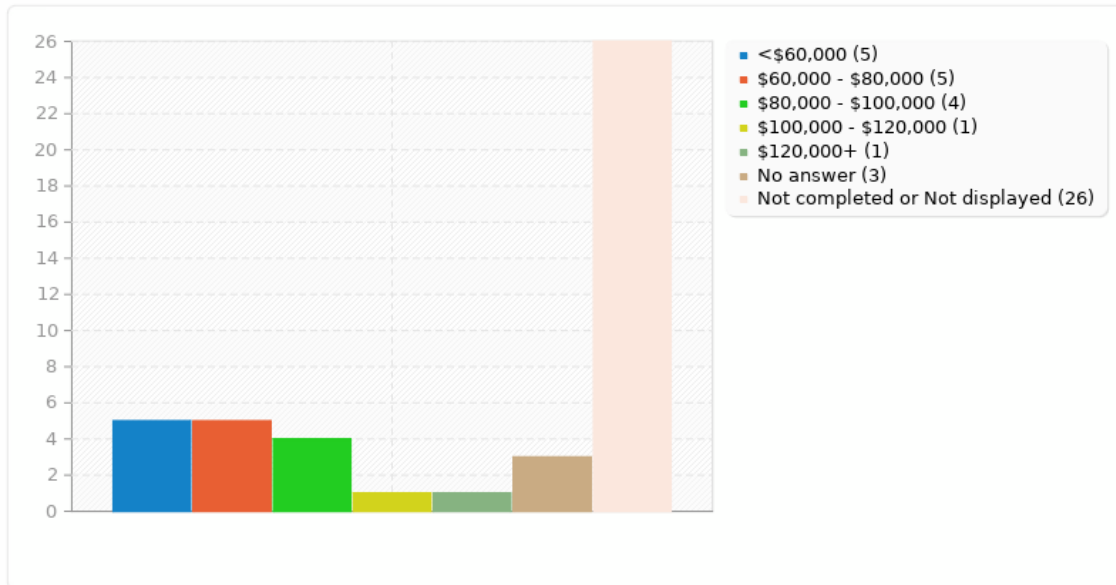

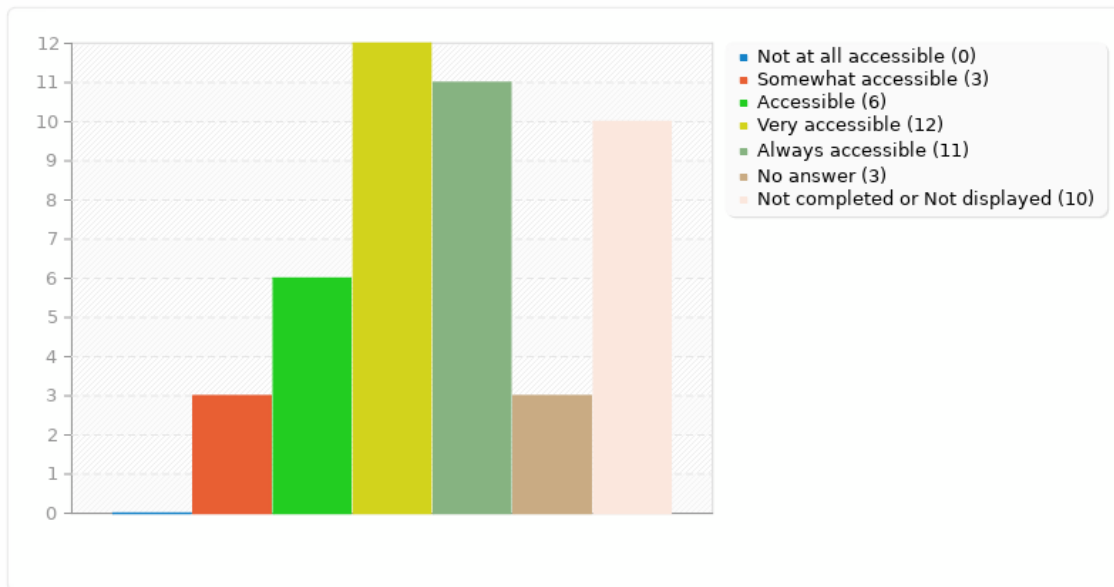

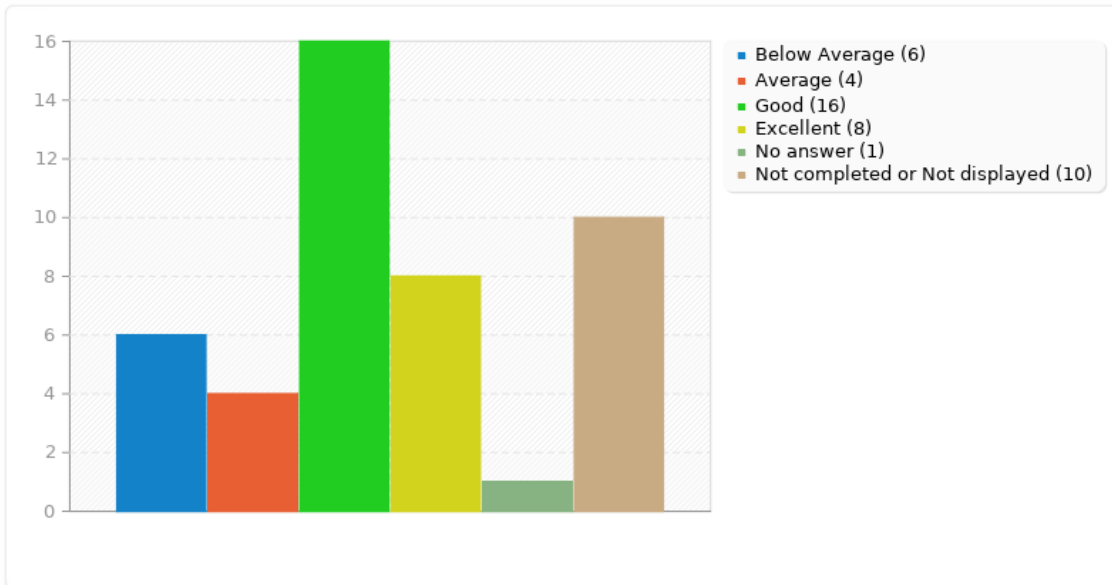

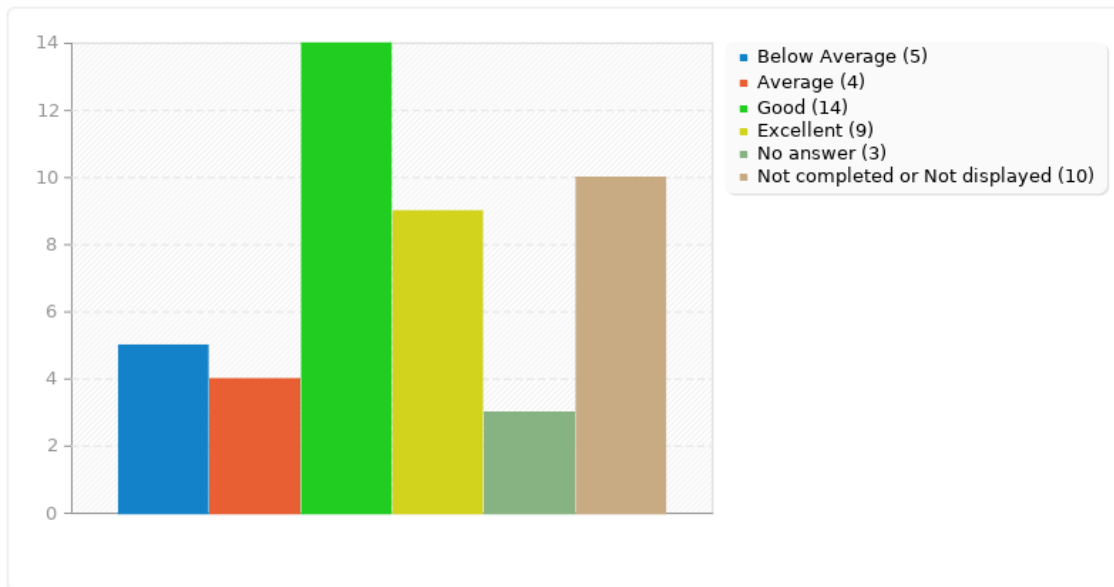

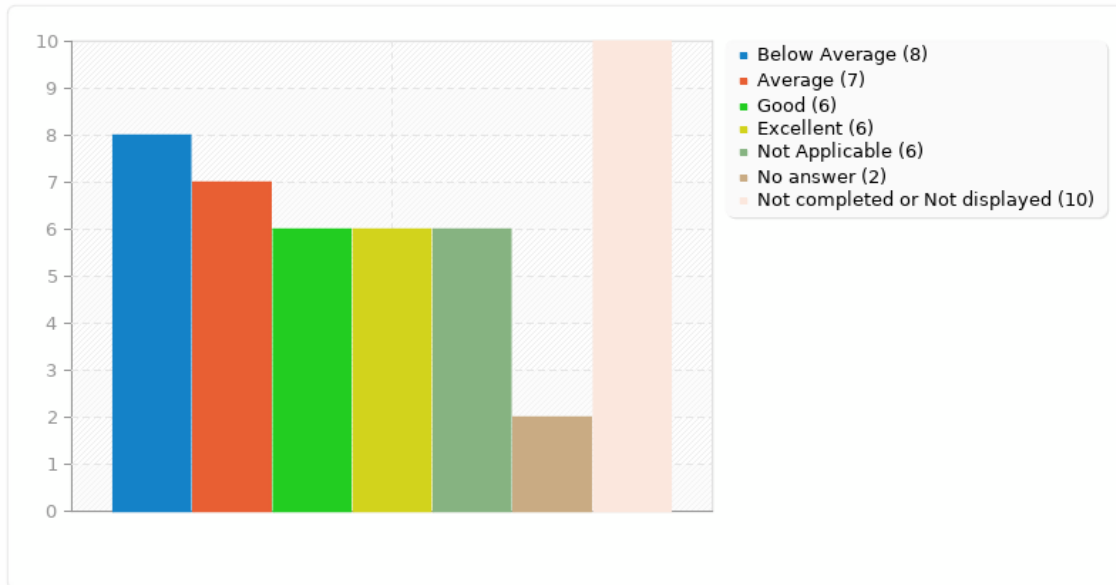

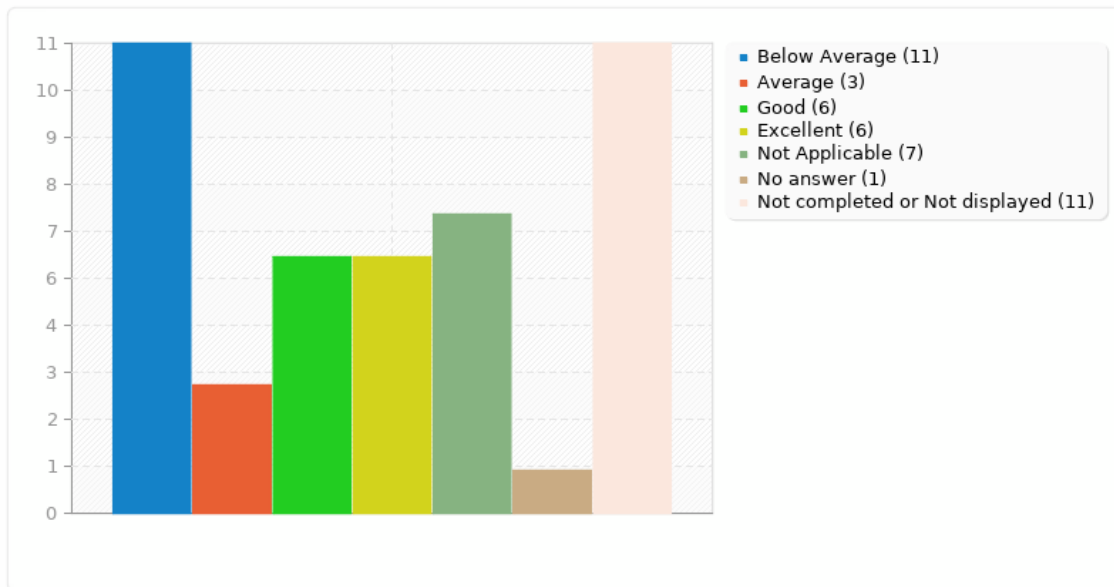

The Master's graduate program is limited, because it requires more action and consideration from the student's perspective (what is their thesis topic? what is their course specialization? what do these decisions relate to their career goals), but I think this is common across all graduate programs in all schools. On a related note, career options are often much more limited after receiving a MSc/PhD based on assumptions of your fit to a role from your research, I think being aware of this would give students pause before considering graduate-level education.

Overall, the only improvement I can think of is to stress to students the importance of their involvement of their own education: while a Bachelor's degree can be mostly a general classification, anything higher will reduce your career options but prepare you better for the specific roles that remain. Any research component should be done with career goals in mind (more interaction with hiring third-party companies and their projects may help drive this), and should be determined by the student (not reliant on the supervisor's suggestions based on their own available research opportunities). Anything less can result in a dead-end for career paths after graduation.

It's a real shame -- I filed complaints about this after the first two years and we got a partial cleaning. Ridiculous.
