



GSS REFERENDUM CODE OF CONDUCT

The following Code of Conduct is a standard in which all students shall follow when participating in the referendum process.

All students shall:

- ✓ Be polite, courteous, and respectful to all members, faculty and community stakeholders
- ✓ Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all participants and refrain from any form of discrimination against others (including age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs, or sexual identity)
- ✓ Avoid bullying, the use of bad language or making offensive remarks (including inappropriate use/abuse of social media or networking websites and mobile technology), making racial/sectarian references, and general inappropriate behaviour
- ✓ Not harass, bully, or intimidate a member to vote
- ✓ Not harass, slander, libel any member or opposition
- ✓ Sabotage the campaigns of others
- ✓ Not aggressively campaign towards any member/opposition
- ✓ Not use drugs or alcohol as their campaign materials or campaign where drugs or alcohol are being used or served.
- ✓ Not state gross misrepresentation of facts
- ✓ Not campaign in the GSS offices
- ✓ Respect the policies and procedures of the University of Windsor's' Student Code of Conduct
