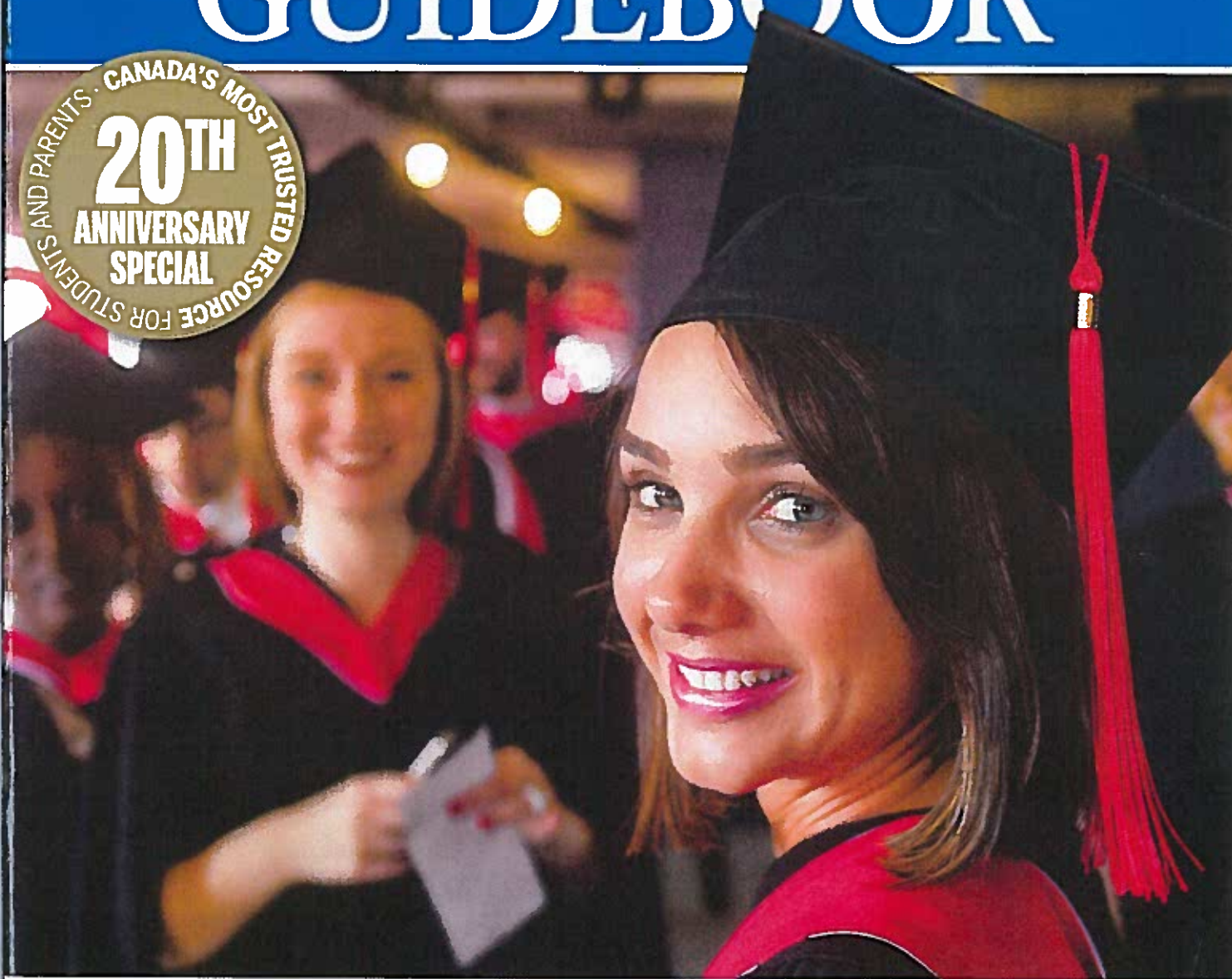

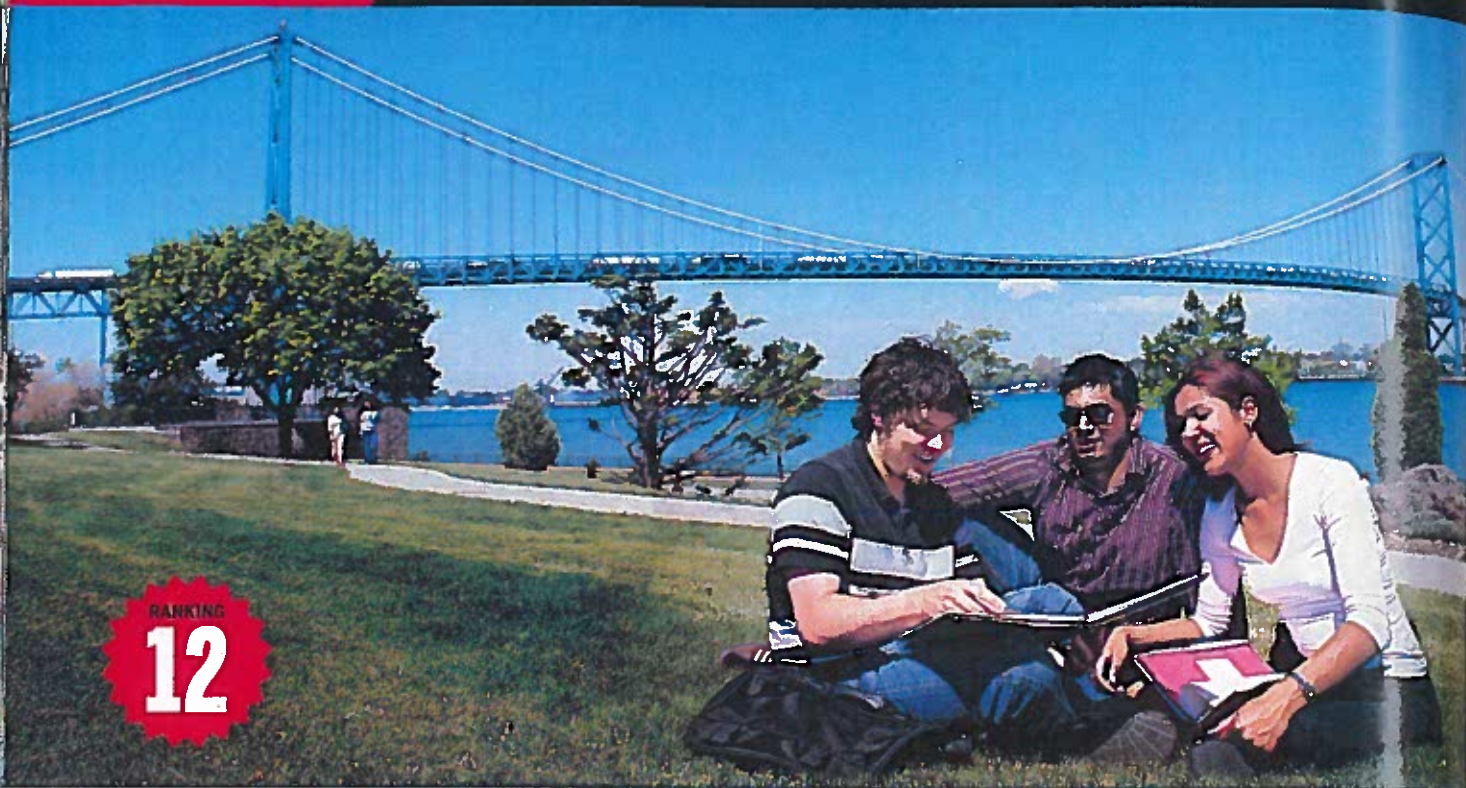

University of Windsor | Windsor, Ont. Founded 1857

The University of Windsor takes advantage of its location at the busiest border crossing in Canada, right next to Detroit, a fascinating city undergoing a period of urban renewal. It hosts the Cross-Border Institute and offers programs in partnership with U.S. schools, such as the University of Michigan and Wayne State University. One example is the dual J.D. program, a collaboration with the University of Detroit Mercy, which provides law graduates with the ability to practise law in Canada and the U.S. The new \$112-million Ed Lumley Centre for Engineering Innovation, which connects engineering and business students with entrepreneurs, hints at a city in transition from automotive town to diversified economy. There are strong social work programs and a faculty of medicine and dentistry, too. The campus has beautiful buildings, such as the 1928 red-brick Dillon Hall, and is connected to a band of grass along the river with a view of the Detroit skyline. Renovations are nearly done on three buildings that will allow social work, film production, executive education, visual arts and music students to study downtown. Says

president Alan Wildeman: "We make every effort to create a learning environment that emphasizes student engagement, and one where the classroom and the laboratory prepare students for the opportunities and challenges that begin with graduation."

Standout Programs

- **Human Kinetics:** Provides students with an understanding of human physical activity in its broadest sense; includes a co-op option. Students specialize in one of three honours majors: movement science, sport management or sport studies.
- **Visual Arts and the Built Environment:** Students examine cities from aesthetic, social, architectural and historical perspectives. Half of the classes take place in Detroit.
- **Medical Physics:** This B.Sc. Honours degree includes a mix of credits that leave graduates well-positioned to move into programs in radiology or medical imaging.

Cool Courses

- **Border Culture:** Addresses the role of borders in contemporary global culture. Stu-

dents exchange views based on their experience living in a border town.

- **Forensic Identification:** A practical application of principles and protocols used in forensic identification. Topics include legal responsibilities of crime-scene specialists and fingerprint theory.
